MODERN BY TRADITION

1743 Friedrich University founded by Margrave Friedrich von Bayreuth

1769 The University is named Friedrich-Alexander University in honour of its patron Margrave Alexander von Ansbach und Bayreuth

1824 University hospital opened

1928 Faculty of Sciences founded

1961 Integration of the Nuremberg Commercial College as the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences

1966 Foundation of the Faculty of Engineering- the first faculty of applied engineering in Germany at a traditional university

1972 Integration of the Teacher Training College in Nuremberg as the Faculty of Education Science

2007 The University is restructured into 5 faculties

FAU – teacher – training

About 5 500 students in Teacher Education

third largest location of teacher training in Bavaria

teacher training courses for

- primary school
- secondary modern school
- middle school
- grammar school
- vocational schools

in 4 faculties (except medicine)

at two locations: Erlangen + Nürnberg
